Mike Scruggs

Mike Scruggs is a realtor and retired financial executive living in Hendersonville, NC. He holds a BS from the University of Georgia and an MBA from Stanford University. He is a former USAF intelligence officer and a combat veteran of the Vietnam War, holding a Distinguished Flying Cross, Air Medal, and Purple Heart. He is a former Republican County Chairman and until recently was Chairman of the Board of a Classical Christian School. He is the author of *"The Un-Civil War: Truths Your Teacher Never Told You"*.

SUBJECT: Un-Civil War in Missouri. Topics will include: origins of the Kansas-Missouri border war from 1855 to 1861; John Brown's abolitionist terrorism in Kansas; the Lincoln administration's suppression of secession and civil rights; widespread Union atrocities against civilians including especially war crimes in St. Louis, Palmyra, Osceola, Kansas City, and several western Missouri counties; raids by Kansas Jayhawkers and Redlegs; Quantrill and his Missouri Partisan Rangers; Quantrill's raid on Lawrence, Kansas; Order Number 11, Sterling Price and the Missouri Guard; Joseph Shelby; and the impact of Union terrorism on Jesse and Frank James, the Younger brothers, and "Bloody Bill" Anderson.
