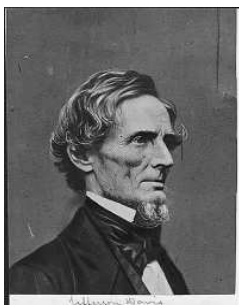
“War Conspiracy of 1861”

A Business graduate from Bob Jones University, he is a member of the Brigadier General Samuel McGowan Camp #0040 in Laurens, South Carolina where he has served as both Lt. Commander and Commander. He also represented the South Carolina’s Division 1st

Bridgade on the Heritage Committee and has held the office of South Carolina Division Adjutant since 2004. In addition to other duties, he was the Adjutant-in-Chief under Commander-in-Chief Chris Sullivan from 2006 to 2008 and continues to serve in the same capacity under Commander-in-Chief Chuck McMichael of Shreveport, Louisiana.

Lexington, VA*

On January 17th in Lexington, VA, Robert E. Lee and “Stonewall” Jackson were honored in an annual tradition of parades, memorial services, and museum tours. The day began with a service at Stonewall Jackson’s memorial. Then through the streets of Lexington marched a parade of participating camps and their families. Then it was on to a tour of the Robert E. Lee Chapel where a service was held in his honor at noon.

But, even after a luncheon and all the planned events were finished, this small town in Virginia boasts some big historical sights to see. Lexington is home to Washington Lee University named for George Washington and Robert E. Lee. The University is home



to Lee Chapel and the famous Robert E. Lee statue of Lee resting in the battlefield. Also, in Lexington is the Stonewall Jackson Cemetery and the only home of Jackson. Down the road is Virginia Military Institute with more history and sights to see.
